Read the book aloud with students (K-2)

Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever had to eat or drink something that didn't taste good? Have you ever gotten sick from eating or drinking something? What was it, and how did it make you feel?
- Can you imagine if you couldn't play or go to school because your family needed help to get water to drink or grow food?
- What are ways that you could help kids have access to water?

Activities/Ideas:

- Math: Host our own fundraiser where your children/students give up something (special drinks or snacks) and donate the cost difference to a water-related charity. (H2O for Life!)
- Math: Have students run a lemonade stand or car wash. Collect pennies or aluminum cans.
- Writing: Write letters or schedule speaking opportunities for students to talk about what they've learned and to encourage adults to make a donation to H2O for Life and our partner school.
- Writing: Choose a student of the week to feature: How can they/did they make a difference in the life of another child? Have their parents help them write/illustrate what they did/will do and share it with the class.
- Writing: Write about how you would feel if you didn't have fresh water to drink.
- Science: Design/write about a machine that would change dirty water into fresh water.
